Ada Utilities is a language-sensitive toolset for quality and standards auditing of whole Ada projects. It combines the power of Ada-ASSURED with tools for auditing, searching, transforming, and pretty printing entire projects.

The Linux versions of Ada-ASSURED and Ada-Utilities are currently available directly from GrammaTech, and will be available through Aonix in the first quarter of 2002.
